Introduction

Improve access to land, technology, financial services (such as credit and insurance), and employment opportunities.

Strengthen resilience:

Build the resilience of the poor and reduce their vulnerability to climate-related events, economic shocks, and other disasters.

3.NSPI authorities take actions which focused on supporting poor families. They manage and control the activities regularly.

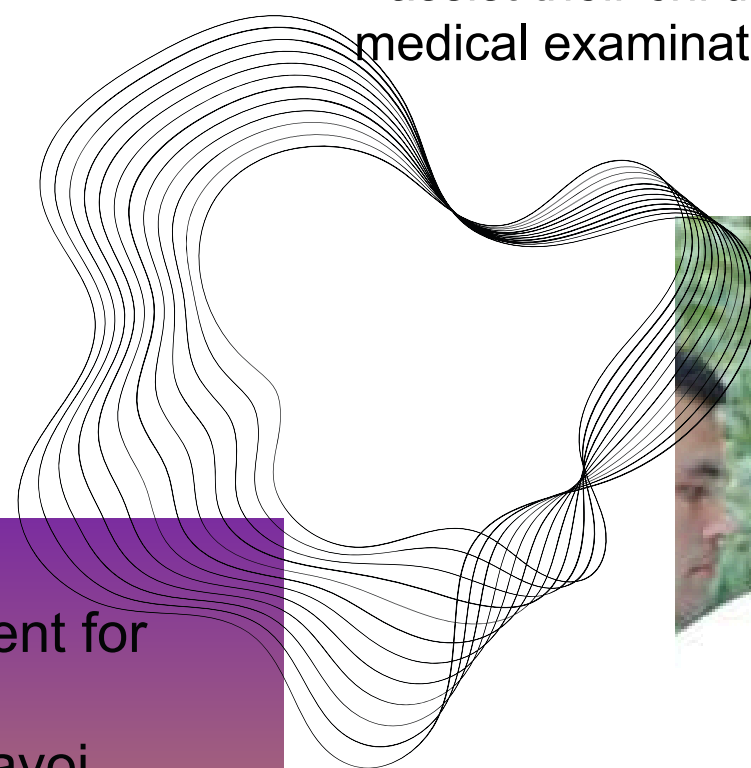
4. Financial department of the university provides students with tuition fee discounts, free dormitory access, food and transportation aids.





Rector of Navoi State University, Mukhiddin Kalonov, together with the head of the “Umid” Mahalla Citizens’ Assembly in Navoi city, Shermat Kholiqov, visited households in the mahalla to study the living conditions of residents included in the registry of socially vulnerable and low-income families.

During the visit, the needs of residents living on Karimov Street were examined, and measures were determined to provide them with suitable employment, assist their children in obtaining quality education, ensure medical examinations, and offer practical support to improve their material well-being.



Systematic cooperation will be carried out with the Department for Poverty Reduction and Employment

A cooperation meeting was held between the Rector of Navoi State University, Professor Mukhiddin Kalonov, and the Head of the Navoi Regional Department for Poverty Reduction and Employment, Lutfullo Khayrullayev.
