
The active participation of university students in this initiative was highly appreciated, and they were awarded **commemorative gifts** by the organizers.


These initiatives are expected to contribute to the development of environmentally friendly infrastructure and more sustainable communities, supporting the goals of Sustainable Cities and Communities.






Birdhouses Installed at Navoi State University in Honor of International Bird Day
