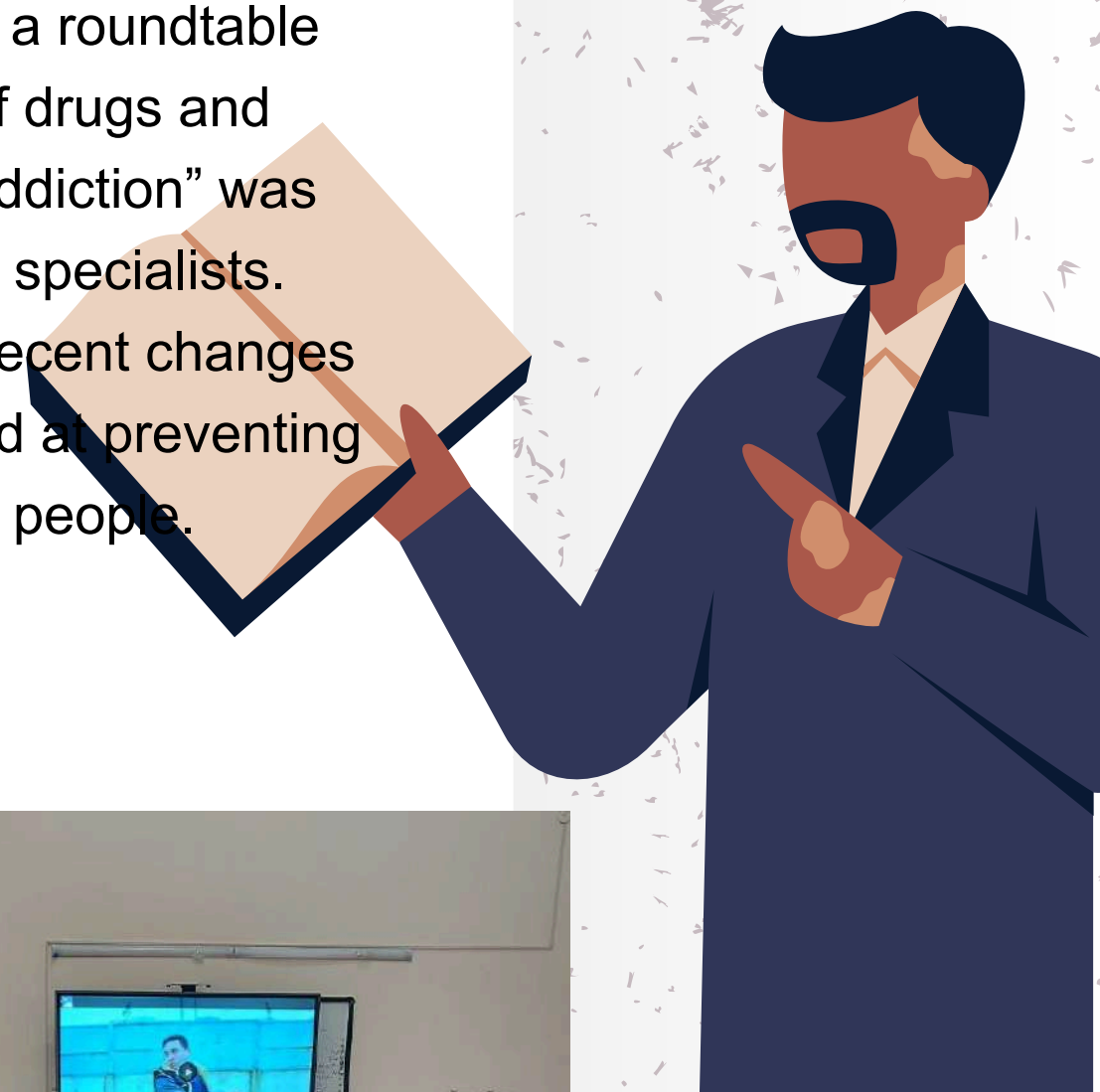
During the event, a presentation from the Investigation Department under the Navoi City Department of Internal Affairs was read out and discussed in detail.



# AWARENESS — THE DEMAND OF THE TIME

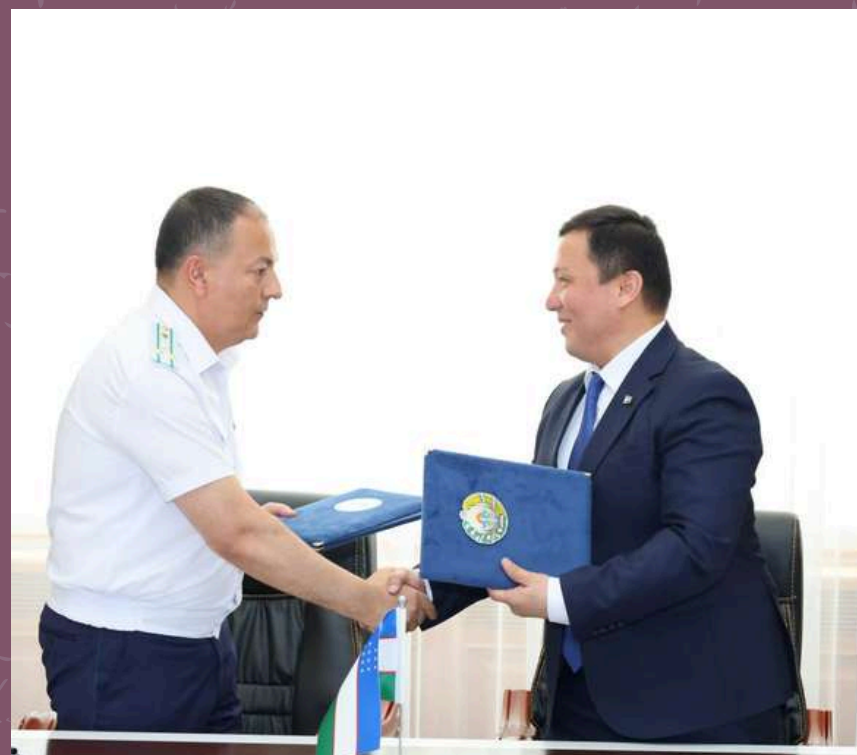
⚡ Under this theme, preventive dialogues are being conducted in the faculties of Navoiy State Pedagogical Institute.

In particular, recently, at the Faculty of Preschool and Primary Education, a roundtable discussion on “Preventing crime among youth, preventing the spread of drugs and psychotropic substances, as well as the harmful consequences of drug addiction” was organized with the participation of law enforcement officers and medical specialists. During the preventive event, responsible officials provided information on recent changes in the national legislation system, the causes of crime, and measures aimed at preventing crime, drug addiction, and other negative phenomena among young people.





# A MEMORANDUM WAS SIGNED TO STRENGTHEN COOPERATION WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES



Today, a cooperation memorandum was signed between the Prosecutor of Navoiy Region, Abduqahhor Mullajanov, and the Rector of Navoiy State University, Professor Muxiddin Kalonov. The memorandum aims to strengthen relations between higher education institutions in the region and law enforcement agencies, jointly combat corruption and legal violations, enhance legal awareness, establish sports clubs at the university, increase the effectiveness of spiritual and educational activities, and implement effective measures to prevent crime among young people.





SDG 16's conclusion is that peace, justice, and strong institutions are fundamental prerequisites for achieving all other sustainable development goals, and progress on this goal is essential for human progress and stability. It calls for peaceful and inclusive societies by building effective, accountable, and inclusive institutions, which requires ending violence and ensuring access to justice for all. While some areas like homicide rates have decreased, progress is mixed globally, with ongoing challenges such as increased human trafficking and declining rule of law and democracy in some regions.
